Rules, Regulations & General Information

For All competitors and spectators, please read carefully before submitting entries and packages.

1. All Pro/Am teachers, students, professionals, and amateur couples are required to have a **2021** Registration Number with the NDCA. (Pro/Am students DO need to be registered.)

2. Material danced should be based on the NDCA approved syllabi. Lifts are allowed only in solo exhibitions. All Closed categories will be invigilated for compliance with the NDCA approved syllabus lists. This competition is governed by the rules and regulations set forth by the NDCA.

3. Teachers can only have one (1) entry per dance, level and age combination. Competition events will be run only once; therefore a teacher cannot dance the same event with two different students.

4. Pro/Am Competitors and Student/Student Competitors are allowed to dance two (2) consecutive divisions. For example, a student may dance all the Bronze (pre-bronze, intermediate bronze, full bronze and open bronze) divisions plus all of the Silver Divisions.

5. Adult Amateur Competitors may dance in any two (2) consecutive age categories for which they are age-eligible. Preteen/Junior/Youth Amateur Competitors may dance in their correct age category plus one (1) age category older. Amateur Competitors may dance any 2 consecutive proficiency levels in a given style; proficiency levels may be different in different styles.

6. Preteen competitors, whether in Pro/Am or Amateur events, must dress according to current NDCA dress code, regardless of age category of entry.

7. Solos are limited to 4 (four) per student. The maximum duration per solo is 4 minutes, including entrance and exit. You must provide your own music on an individually labeled cd with student's name and solo number.

Please note on the entry form if you want your solos to be danced on Thursday morning (T), or Friday morning (F), or any morning Thursday or Friday (A).

The five solo routines with the highest average scores will be invited to compete in the Top Solo Grand Prix held during an evening session to determine the Overall Top Solo for this year's Hawaii Star Ball.

8. Scholarships: In order to register for a scholarship, student must dance a full round of single dance entries in the same category and level

as the scholarship. A full round shall be 4 Smooth single dances or 5 Ballroom, Latin, or Rhythm Single Dances.

9. The organizer reserves the right to combine events by merging age or proficiency levels of events with fewer than 3 entries without prior notification to the competitors.

11. No responsibility for loss of theft of articles left in changing rooms, ballrooms, or hotel rooms can be accepted by The Hawaii Star Ball, by the organizer, David Alvarez, or any of his officers, or by the NDCA Inc., and neither can they be held liable for injury sustained by persons attending the event. Everyone attending The Hawaii Star Ball does so at his or her own risk. All persons attending The Hawaii Star Ball, whether as spectators, competitors, officials or guests shall be bound by current NDCA rules and, by participating in any capacity in The Hawaii Star Ball, will be obliged to adhere to them.

12. HOTEL

- The closing date for hotel reservations is **September 17th, 2021** to guarantee a room at the Sheraton Waikiki at our group rate. Our room block is limited, so please make reservations early, and mention the Hawaii Star Ball to get the correct room rate.
- All hotel reservations are the responsibility of the participants unless on VIP package. There are a limited number of rooms available a few days before and after the competitions dates. Please book your rooms early.

13. PAYMENT POLICIES

- Payment must accompany entry forms. Entries are not considered to be complete without payment.
- Entries and/or payments made after **September 24th, 2021**, must be in the form of a Certified or Cashiers' Check or Credit Card. No personal or business checks will be accepted after **September 24th, 2021**.

- You will receive confirmation of your entries and packages. Please check very carefully that no mistakes have been made.

14. REFUND POLICIES

- Packages, entries and room reservations can be cancelled, in writing, and must be received at least forty-five (45) days prior to the first day of the event. Top Awards & Prize Money

Hawai'i Star Ball Top Teacher, Top Students and Top Studio awards are based on both entries and placements. Teachers and students must dance the events to earn points. Teachers that dance Pro/Am and also have amateur couples dancing in separate events will be awarded "coaching" points and will accumulate points per couple. Coach and amateur couple **MUST** be identified at the time of registration. There will be no points awarded for any scratched or missed entries for any reason. Each entry, whether for single dance, multi-dance challenge or scholarship event will receive a single entry point. Placement points will be awarded according to the following schedule:

Proficiency

1 pt per entry, no extra points for placements

1-2 Dance events

1st= 8pts 2nd=7pts 3rd=6pts 4th=5pts 5th=4pts 6th=3pts
7th=2pts 8th=1pt plus 4pts/recall

3-5 Dance events

1st=20pts 2nd=15pts 3rd=10pts 4th=8pts 5th=6pts
6th=4pts 7th=2pts 8th=2pts plus 5pts/recall

Youth Events will accumulate points at ½ the above rate.

2021 Top Teacher Awards

A teacher may only win ONE top teacher award, either an Overall Award or one of the Top 3 Female or Male Awards.

OVERALL Top Teacher Awards

1st Place (minimum 325 pro/am entries): \$7,000*
2nd Place (minimum 275 pro/am entries): \$5,000*
3rd Place (minimum 250 pro/am entries): \$3,500*

Female Top Teacher

The Top 3 Female Teachers that did not place in the Overall Top 3

1st Place (minimum 200 pro/am entries): \$2,000*
2nd Place (minimum 150 pro/am entries): \$1,500
3rd Place (minimum 100 pro/am entries): \$1,000

Male Top Teacher

The Top 3 Male Teachers that did not place in the Overall Top 3

1st Place (minimum 200 pro/am entries): \$2,000*
2nd Place (minimum 150 pro/am entries): \$1,500
3rd Place (minimum 100 pro/am entries): \$1,000

All prizes will be awarded as long a minimum entries are met; however only the amount of money qualified for will be given out. For example, if the 1st place Top Teacher has only 300 pro/am entries, he or she will receive \$5,000, not \$7,000. In the same scenario, if the 2nd place Top Teacher also has 300 pro/am entries, he or she will also earn \$5,000. If there are not 9 qualified Top Teacher candidates, then fewer places will be awarded.

***Teachers AND Students must be on a package (Big Kahuna, VIP, or A) to qualify for the award money for the top 3 overall and 1st place Female or Male Top Teacher Awards regardless of number of entries.**
